Australia Square & MLC Centre Exhibition (12 – 31 October, 2009) Application for Entry

Conditions of Entry

1. Selection is at the discretion of the Committee and no correspondence will be entered into. All works may not be accepted, especially if we have a great many entries. In addition, the exhibition venue manager retains the right to require the Society to withdraw any work for any reason.
2. All works must be free standing, new to Australia Square/MLC and the sculptor's original work.
3. Maximum height is three metres and maximum floor space is 1m by 1m. The weight and material of the sculpture must not have the potential to damage the surface of the floor. All small or light weight sculptures not secured to the plinth will be rejected.
4. Plinths must be in good condition & freshly painted black or white (unless the plinth is part of the sculpture). Plinths must have felt on the bottom.
5. All sculptures must be for sale. No 'price on application'.
6. If you are registered for GST, your price must include GST and you are responsible for remitting the GST to the ATO.
7. All exhibitors are expected to volunteer for the roster at the exhibition - 10.30am to 3.00pm Monday to Friday
8. Applications for entry close **Friday 11th September, 2009**. All information requested on application form must be provided.
9. Exhibition set up: **Sunday 11th October** between 9am and 12 noon. Dismantling: **Sunday 1st November** between 9am and 12 noon.

Include with your application

1. Photographs that clearly show your proposed entry, labelled with your name, title of work, material and dimensions of the work. Note that photographs must show good contrast, have an uncluttered background, and be of a quality fit for reproduction in print. (If you wish to have your work considered for use in promoting the exhibition, please also include a CD with your images. This is in **addition to printed photos not instead of them**)
2. Your entry fee of \$40. This may be refunded if your application is unsuccessful
3. Stamped and self addressed envelope for notification of your results and return of photographs

Please read and sign the following

1. I have read the conditions of entry above and agree to be bound by them.
2. I appoint the Society as my agent to offer the work(s) for sale on my behalf.
3. I accept full responsibility for any damage to, loss or theft of my exhibited work(s).
4. I agree to a 15% commission payable on all sales (10% commission to the Sculptors Society and 5% to venue) plus payment of credit card charges (if applicable), and I agree that these will be deducted from any money payable to me.
5. I certify that the art work is my original work and does not breach any other artist's copyright.
6. I certify that my works will be of sound and robust construction and will pose no danger to the public.
7. I give permission for photos of my work to be used in promotion for the exhibition and the Society.
